Carry In, Carry Out:

• Please help us keep the Dog House and the grounds neat by carrying out all of your trash.

There are no trash barrels in the Hollow on purpose. Remember, <u>Carry In</u>, <u>Carry Out</u>! Do not leave your empty shell boxes and other trash behind.

• <u>Reminder</u>: The barrels at next to the warming hut at the shotgun range are for expended shotgun shells only / <u>not trash</u>!!!!!!! If you contaminate the barrels with trash the company that recycles the spent hulls will no longer take them away.

<u>The Brass Factory / News from the ~ The Pistol</u> <u>House & Rifle Shed</u>:

• Remember – Members always have priority at shooting stations over guests.

Always Post the Range Flags When Shooting:

Alert other shooters when you intend to go down range to look at or collect your targets. Shooters at both ranges are to "cease fire" <u>at both sites</u> "before any shooter travels down range".

Please, collect /sweep up your brass after you finish shooting.
