General Guidelines and Requirements for Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club Members Accessing Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club Property/Facilities

Until further notice, in order to be eligible to access and/or utilize Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club property for any reason the following guidelines/requirements, based on CDC guidelines for preventing transmission, self-distancing and self-quarantine must be met.

In order to be eligible to access or utilize Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club property/facilities, you must answer each of the following four (4) yes or no questions:

1. Have you had an elevated temperature within the last 72 hours?
2. Have you been in close contact (been within 6' while NOT wearing a mask) with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or with anyone who is showing symptoms?
3. Have you exhibited any of the following symptoms in the last 72 hours, while not using any fever- reducing medication: Fever, Chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Headache, Muscle pain, Loss of taste/smell, gastrointestinal issues?
4. Have you travelled by plane, train, or bus in the last 14 days?

If the answer to any of these questions is “*yes*”, you are **NOT** eligible to access and/or utilize Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club property until **BOTH** of the following have occurred: 7 days have passed since the symptoms first appeared **AND** 3 days have passed since the symptoms have disappeared. The person should consult a doctor and follow the doctor’s instructions.

Hamilton Wenham Rod and Gun Club Temporary COVID-19 Protocols

- Range specific protocols will be posted at each range. These protocols **must** be followed.
 - Archery Range is limited to 6 members at any one time.
 - Rifle Range: shooters must use only benches 1, 3, and 5.
 - Pistol House: shooters may use every other window.
 - Shot gun Range: maintain 6 feet between stands, members can place their own fees into envelope. Bring exact change \$4.00 per round.
 - If you must wait for a position inside the Rifle Shed or the Pistol House wear a mask.

- **All special events and competitions are suspended until further notice.**

You, as members, are responsible to follow the rules to minimize the risk to yourself and others.

You are ultimately responsible for your own health and safety.

Those members using our facilities are required to follow the Massachusetts COVID-19 Prevention guidelines and the protocols posted at each range. Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club Prevention of the Spread of COVID-19 Guidelines

- **Stay 6 feet away from others. Masks or face coverings (supplied by you) are required when this is not possible.**
- Don't shake hands. Gatherings of more than 10 people are not allowed. A gathering is defined as persons in close proximity to others in a room, enclosed area or congregated in a specific location.
- Wash your hands often with soap and warm water thoroughly for at least 20 seconds. If washing is not possible, sanitize hands (minimum 60% alcohol-based sanitizers) frequently. **You are responsible to provide your own hand sanitizer.**
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Practice respiratory etiquette, including appropriately covering coughs and sneezes (inside of elbow, not your hand).
- Avoid sharing equipment.
- Clean **and** disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes, but is not limited to, tables, shooting stations, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, toilets, faucets, locks, lockboxes, and sinks.
- Use an EPA-registered disinfectant when cleaning surfaces. Each Range will have a disinfectant solution for surface disinfecting. **Each member is responsible to provide his/her personal mask and disinfectant wipes/solution.** (For a current list of EPA-registered disinfectants go to <https://www.epa.gov/pesticide-registration/list-n-disinfectants-use-against-sars-cov-2>) The Hamilton Wenham Rod & Gun Club is not responsible for damage to clothing, shooting bags, etc. from disinfecting solutions used on surfaces.
- Always observe all firearm and range safety practices. Keep in mind your own personal safety and the safety of those fellow members around you.
