All Members:

How to use the gate key card: (see short video here)

Gate Operating Instructions to Enter & Exit the Club:

- 1. Pull up to the keypad
- 2. "Pass" your card across the face of the keypad.
- 3. You will hear a chirp acknowledging that your card has been read.
- 4. Gate will open.
- 5. Promptly drive through the gate.

Reminders:

- The Gate will allow ONLY one vehicle to pass before closing.
- DO NOT attempt to pass a gate opening with two vehicles as the gate will close upon the
- 2nd vehicle, damaging the vehicle and the gate!
- Each vehicle will need to individually activate the gate.

In the Event of:

Loss of power (low or dead battery):

The gate bar will be upright. It is safe to drive under the gate in this position. The gate arm will return to the closed position when the battery is charged or replaced.

Mechanical failure-gate not lifting:

If David is not available, call Patrick Cullen, club President, at 978-473-3040.

Emergency:

Call 911 immediately. Get needed supplies from the new medical/trauma stations at the Pistol House OR the Dog House at the Shotgun Range and wait for help to arrive. Both Police and Ambulance drivers know how to activate the gate.

Lost gate key card:

Notify the club Secretary, **The cost to you to replace your lost card is \$20.** The replacement card will need to be reprogrammed and may take up to two weeks before receiving it.

FINAL NOTE CONTINUE TO CARRY YOUR GATE KEY IN THE EVENT WE TEMPORARILY NEED TO USE THE CHAIN.
